**CALL FOR ERASMUS+ OUTGOING SHORT STUDENT MOBILITIES  
BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME – KA131  
Clinical Skills Training for Pharmacists in General Practice  
academic year 2025/26**

In the framework of the Erasmus+ Programme – KA131 Learning Mobility of Individuals, and based on the results and the funds awarded under the project **BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME Clinical Skills for Pharmacists in General Practice**, hereafter referred to as “BIP”, a call for **students’ selection** is published to assign contributions to take part into the **BIP**.

The BIP is organized with the collaboration of these Universities and School of Pharmacy of Europe: Pavia (Italy), Paris-Saclay (France), Trinity College of Dublin (Ireland), Vilnius (Lithuania).

This project will engage up to 10 students in addressing some amongst the most pressing educational and professional challenges.

The project will focus on complementary activities and training offered to students who aim to become community pharmacists in order to help them managing all their new missions to the patients. Clinical skills are becoming increasingly important for community pharmacists as they take on more patient-facing roles in primary care (*i.e.*, advice to patients, vaccination, tests, follow-up of treatment). Not all European universities teach in-depth practical clinical skills in their Pharmacy studies.

During the virtual phase (25<sup>th</sup> May – 5<sup>th</sup> June 2026), students will follow theoretical classes with adapted activities (ice-breaking, preparation for practice, communication skills, fundamental notions of clinical pharmacy, intercultural exchange), and, above all, a methodology for approaching their patients holistically, correctly, and efficiently.

In the in-person phase (8<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> June 2026), students will convene in Pavia (ITALY) to share their findings, learn from experts, and refine their knowledge and competences. Lessons on specific topics will be taught by lectures of the four Universities involved in the BIP: communication with patients about their prescribed treatment and reconciliation therapy, soft skills (communication, organisation), development of a genuine patient relationship, geriatric clinical pharmacy, monitoring drug therapies, management of minor diseases and counselling, preventive health and wellness, and ethics. In addition, practical activities about communication skills for the pharmacist, clinical reasoning [sampling, tests, POC (Point Of Care), POCT (Point Of Care Testing), vaccination (injections, recommendations, allergies), physical assessment skills and patient assessment (vital parameters), and special training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation] will be organized.

This project empowers students to become active promoters of change. They will not only gain technical expertise but also develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills, to address complex environmental issues and contribute to a more sustainable future.





## 1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must fulfil the following compulsory criteria:

- To be duly enrolled at the University of Pavia for the entire duration of the mobility;
- To possess a proficiency in English language of at least a level of CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). Students will be required to communicate and discuss fluently in English, take part in group activities and in general to treat any topic with ease;
- Students should ideally have knowledge in pharmacology, minor ailments, a good grades, no or few exam debts, and be senior students. This ensures a solid foundation for the project.
- Strong Interest in Clinical Pharmacy and Clinical Pharmacy Practice.

## 2. DETAILS ABOUT THE MOBILITY

The BIP Clinical Skills Training for Pharmacists in General Practice will take place **online** before the mobility in presence from 25<sup>th</sup> May to 5<sup>th</sup> June 2026 and in presence at the **University of Pavia, Italy, from 8<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> June** (both included). The course will be considered completed only if the participants will attend the full programme of the entire online part and of the 5 training days in presence.

In addition, BIP participants will also be awarded OPEN BADGE in "Clinical Skills Training for Pharmacists in General Practice".

## 5. EVALUATION AND SELECTION

The selection will be made by a joint Committee established within the **Department of Drug Sciences** headed by the Professors in charge of the BIP for the University of Pavia (Prof. Giovanni Ricevuti and Prof.ssa Marialaura Amadio).

The following criteria will be taken into consideration:

- Soundness and relevance of applicant's interest for the course, as expressed in a motivation letter;
- Relevance of applicant's educational records and expertise to the study program;
- The candidate's level of preparation as assessed through the submitted documentation.

In case of equal evaluation between two candidates, the Evaluation Commission reserves the right to give priority to those applications which add to the diversity of the study programme in terms of gender balance, year of study, and variety of mobility experience.

The Committee reserves the right to check the validity of declarations and supporting documents. False statements may lead to exclusion from the selection process.

Each applicant will be notified about selection results in due time, via the email address provided in the application.

**Selected applicants must then officially accept to attend the entire BIP by answering via email to the received communication.**

## 6. PERSONAL DATA TREATMENT

Personal data submitted by the applicants will be used solely for application and selection procedures and institutional aims, and will be treated in accordance with the European General Data Protection Regulation no. 2016/679 art. 13.
